Allocation of Companies to Themes and Set of Theme Keywords

Company membership of a theme is determined via a Dynamic Classification Algorithm. The algorithm classifies companies using their Worldscope Company Descriptions and determines via a set of keywords which companies are most closely associated with the theme of interest.
